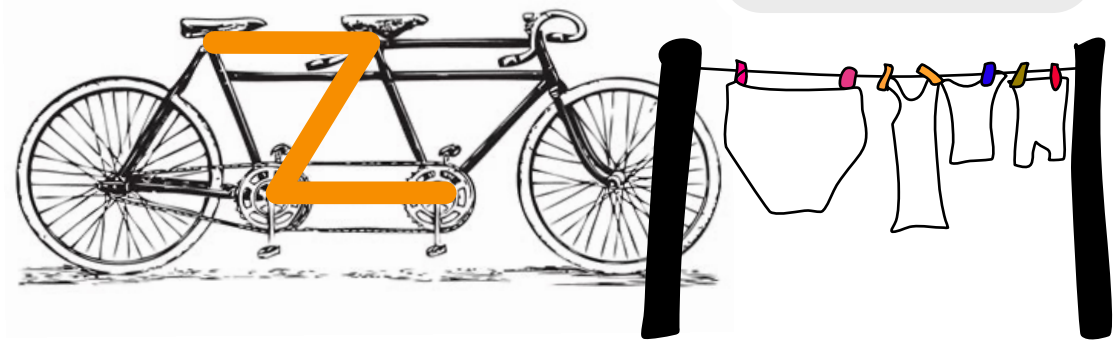


Therefore. thus says the LORD

I have returned to Jerusalem with Mercy



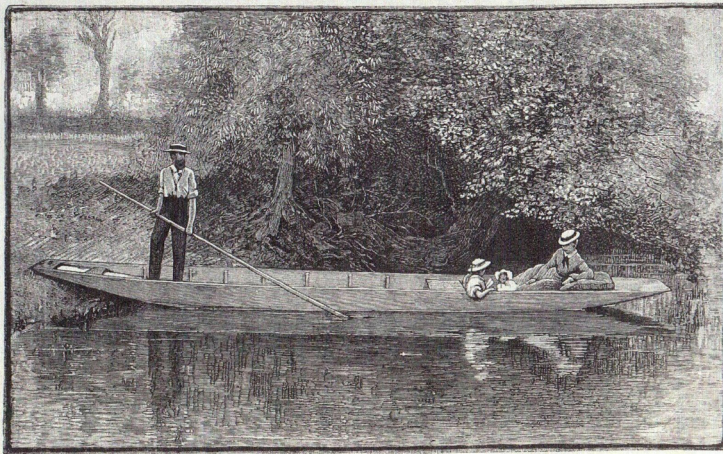
and the measuring line shall be stretched out over Jerusalem
